## Using the Priority Investment Section

### What does a high, medium, or low priority mean?

- ✓ **HIGH:** start implementing the recommendation within 1-3 years of plan adoption
- ✓ **MEDIUM:** start implementing the recommendation within 4-6 years of plan adoption
- ✓ **LOW:** start implementing the recommendation within 7-10 years of plan adoption

### How are priorities assigned?

- ✓ Immediacy of need
- ✓ Relationship to adopted policy goals & priorities
- ✓ Timing can depend on anticipated program, funding, or staff capacity
- ✓ Lower priorities may be staggered to build upon the successful implementation of higher priorities

Anticipated costs, including staff time

¢ = \$0 to \$25,000  
 \$ = \$25,000 to \$50,000  
 \$\$ = \$50,000 to \$100,000  
 \$\$\$ = \$100,000 - \$500,000  
 \$\$\$\$ = \$500,000 to \$1.5M  
 \$\$\$\$\$ = \$1.5M +

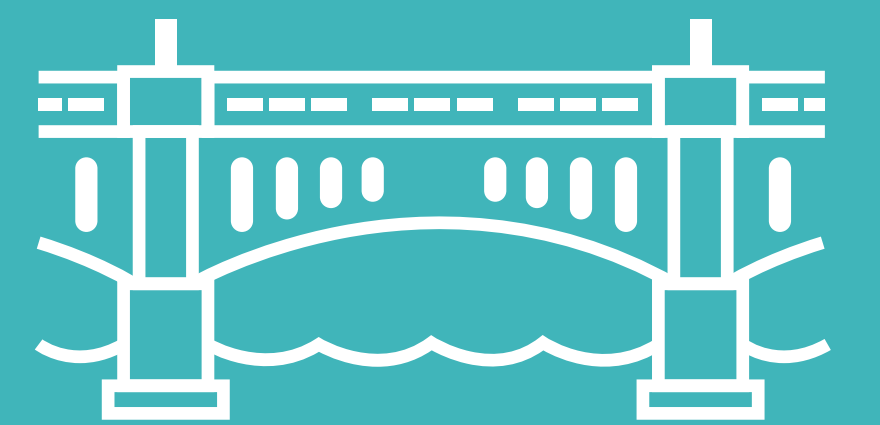

- Gateway Enhancements
- Corridor Projects
- Corridor Enhancements
- Intersection Improvements
- Rail and Transit Projects

How long it should take to complete

- Short = 1-3 years
- Medium = 4-6 years
- Long = 7-10+ years
- Ongoing = implementation should recur on a regular basis (for the example to the left, annual reporting takes a year, however it should occur annually throughout the ten-year time span of Columbia Compass)
